



1. Use a craft knife to carefully cut out each section. Cut slits along the dashed white lines.
2. Assemble the largest section by folding along the lines and inserting the numbered black tabs into their corresponding slots.
3. Attach the smaller sections by inserting tabs into their corresponding slots.

**Tips:** Using heavier paper will make the stadium easier to build and more solid. Card stock is ideal.

Be sure not to cut directly on a desk or table. Use a piece of cardboard or the back of a magazine to make sure you don't damage your tabletop.

You don't need any tape to construct the stadium, but if you plan to keep it around on your desk for a while, a couple pieces on the insides of corners will make sure it doesn't fall apart too easily.
